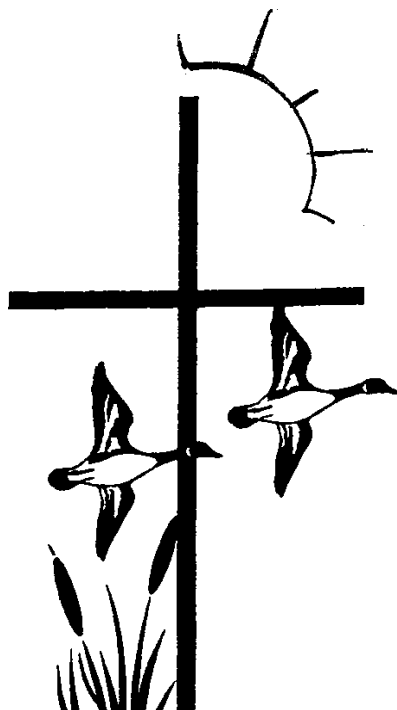

Worship Notes

During this morning's offering, a DVD will be played about the **Christian Reformed World Relief Committee's Disaster Response Services (CRWRC's DRS)**. DRS volunteers give of their time and talents to help clear debris, assess needs, and rebuild homes after disasters strike. They particularly share their services with the elderly, disabled, uninsured, and others with great need. In June 2008, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, "the city that would never flood," was drowned by waters rising twelve feet higher than any previously recorded flood. People were evacuated as floodwaters damaged and destroyed 4,000 homes in Linn County alone. CRWRC's DRS has been on the scene for months. In mid-March, DRS reconstruction teams will begin helping the poorest of the

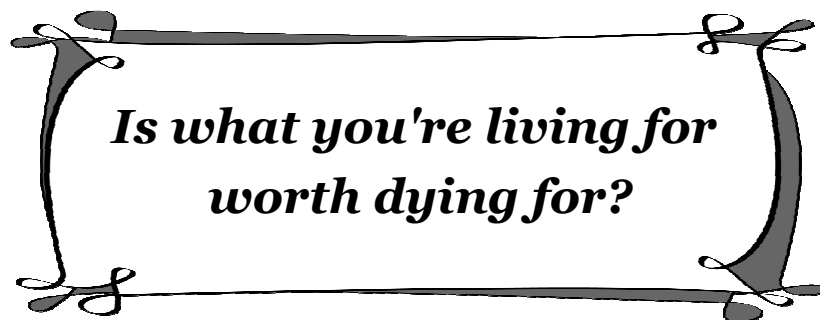
