

**Pastor Ken Van De Griend is leading a tour group to China** from Sept. 10 – 22, 2009. The object of this tour will be to see some of the work that Leadership Resources is doing in China. We will spend a few days in Beijing (Great Wall, Forbidden City, etc.). We will worship with a local legal Three Self Church on Sunday. Then we will travel by air to the ancient capital city of Xian (Terra Cotta Warriors). In Xian we will visit with Underground Church Leaders over dinner. You will have opportunity to ask them questions about Chinese Christianity face to face. Then we will fly to Chong Qing to see the Three Gorges Dam, the Pandas in the Zoo, and then board a river boat that will take us down the Yangtse River for 3 days stopping off at local villages along the way each day. Next we spend 3 days in Shang Hai. We will worship in a legal Three Self Church and see some local sights. We return home Sept. 22 to the States.
