

Proclaiming Evidence for Truth THIS WEEK'S CREATION MOMENT

Young Blood



His heart is as firm as a stone; yea, as hard as a piece of the nether millstone. – Job 41:24

As dinosaur bones containing blood vessels and blood cells are continually being found, more and more laboratories are assigning dates to these bones in the thousands, not millions, of years. This makes evolutionists just like the patient who

goes to his doctor, convinced that he is dead. After failing to convince the patient he is alive, the doctor pricks the man's finger, causing it to bleed. "See?" the doctor says. You must be alive because dead men don't bleed." And the patient replies: "Imagine that! Dead men do bleed after all!"
