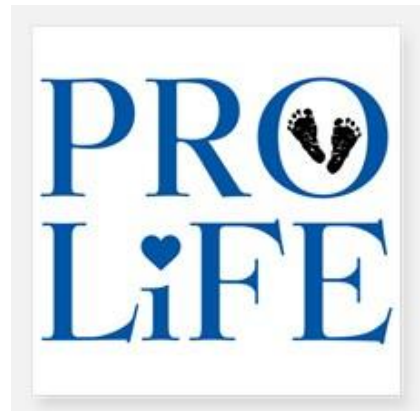

In 2015 the Center for Medical Progress released several video recordings showing Planned Parenthood's involvement in the buying and selling of baby body parts. Since then many questions have been raised regarding the scientific and medical need for such tissues. A US House Select Panel was convened to investigate this issue. The investigation provided overwhelming evidence that such tissue has never been necessary for the development of medical cures nor is it necessary now for continued research and discovery.



Scientists immersed in the field of scientific research will describe why use of fetal tissue for research is both unethical and unnecessary. They will describe why there is much greater promise with many proven results for medical cures using ethical sources of tissue for research, and why making these ethical choices NOW is necessary to preserve future treatment options for all of us. With this information, the audience should be better equipped to promote and support ethical avenues of research here in Wisconsin and nationally.
