Winter/ summer children's, infants/toddlers and men's clothing; winter coats, boots, tennis shoes, mittens, gloves, hats, scarves for all. New socks and underwear. Quilts, blankets, and bedding. New pillows. Ladies clothing is NOT needed. All clothing should be in new or like-new condition. Expiration date should be at least one year out.
