Summer Outdoor Services! Today is the first of three planned monthly outdoor summer worship services. The next two are planned for July 17 and August 28. We're doing this to enjoy God's outdoors, but especially to be a visible and audible presence in the community in our worship. The households within a few blocks of First have been invited through our Outreach Committee and ice cream will be planned after each service for fellowship and connections. If the weather is poor, we will automatically go inside that Sunday and plan on going outdoors the following Sunday. When you arrive for these Sundays, the wagon will be set up and you can find a place to see and listen near it in the parking lot or on the west end of the

lawn between the church and parsonage. Please bring your own lawn chairs. Like our regular worship services, we plan on Livestreaming these outdoor services.

Those who have children enrolling in CWC for the 2022-23 school year are asked to meet in the sanctuary TODAY after the morning service for an informational meeting regarding the **Covenantal Education Plan**.
