More about PAVE: PAVE was launched in 1978 with a simple — but important — mission: Empowering those affected by violence. Their services and programs have expanded significantly over four decades, but our core mission has remained the same. They serve thousands of people every year, working to ensure that no one in Dodge and Jefferson Counties — or anywhere else — should ever be forced into victimhood. In 1990, they opened their first shelter. It is the bedrock of PAVE, and it can comfortably provide refuge for up to 20 people across five rooms. We have our sights set on expanding this important facility in the years to come.


