Welcome to First CRC! We're glad you're here to worship with us today! By God's grace, we're a family of believers that has been gathering to worship God and serve others for some 100 years. We were established out of nearby Alto CRC, in 1921, and later in 1961, Bethel CRC in Waupun, started from members of First.

At First CRC, in Sunday worship and during the week, you'll find many historic and biblical practices of the Christian faith. Our leadership, elders and deacons and pastor, seek to keep these vibrant and relevant to Christians living in today's world.

Child Care and Student Ministries on Sunday Mornings

During worship, we have nursery care for children ages 0-2, and Children's Worship for children ages 3 through 4K. Children's Worship kids are dismissed halfway through the worship service. After worship parents should pick up their children on the upper level where these ministries take place. If you need to take a child out of the worship service for a bit, you may go to our Lower Level where there are two couches and a nearby bathroom. By the couches a TV is playing the service live.

Sunday School and Catechism for K – 12th graders is currently on summer break.

First CRC Youth Ministry Update. The Education Committee is planning on First CRC having our own High School youth group once again, and a Middle School group too as soon as we have adults willing to volunteer. This came about after a decision Bethel CRC recently made about our shared youth groups, followed by conversations with our Council, and Education Committee and youth leaders, as well as an August 3 meeting with parents

and students to talk about proceeding this way as a church. Students of course are free to attend any youth group they would like, but we'd like to encourage our parents and students to commit to building up First's youth group. Please pray for plans being made for First CRC to have a dynamic, intentional, relationship-building, Christ-focused, and substantive youth group for our students.

Young Couples Life Group. This fall Pastor Greg and Sarah and Kevin and Andrea Buwalda plan to lead a Life Group for young couples (roughly, those who have been married 0-20 years) focusing on Christian Marriage. We plan to explore The Five Love Languages of Marriage on the first Sunday evening of each month starting October 5. Home Visitation Ministry. The First CRC elders are excited about a new ministry they have discussed the last months and that has recently begun. Teams of two church members at least 6 times a year are visiting people who the elders have discerned could use some extra care, especially those who are shut-in, but also others who can't always get to church or who are in poor health, or who could perhaps use more fellowship. Please note that these visits are in addition to regular pastor and elder care group care. The teams report visits to one of our elders, Darrall Schaver, as a way of accountability to the elders. Right now we have nine teams who are visiting a total of 24 church members. The elders are very grateful for the people they have approached to do the visiting and for their enthusiasm to serve in this way. If you have someone you think could use this type of extra care, or would like to be involved in visiting, please talk to Darrall Schaver.
