I recently visited the prison and was so blessed the committed lives of the men to the Lord. They were so thankful and joyful that I came to share the message of Jesus with them. They are even sharing it with their families when they visit. I'm truly grateful for the privilege of sharing the goodness with them. They were also thankful for the sanitation kits and treats we brought. Which were a big help, especially for those men whose families live far away and can't visit. Thank you for your help in making this possible. Thank you for being part of this ministry.

Angel and I were able to visit and minister to some of the people we are helping-those who are sick, elderly, disabled, and mentally ill. Thank you for your prayers, continued support for us and most especially for your concern about their relationship with the Lord.

Last week, we had heavy rain due to a typhoon, causing flooding in some areas especially in Luzon. Many people were affected particularly their crops and property. We are keeping then in our prayer. Thankfully, we've had sunny days for the past three days. We're glad we can finally do some work outside, visiting people, sweeping the yard and drying out laundry outside.

Praise God for healing me almost everyday. While I'm not fully healed yet and still have a breathing problems, it may be from my asthma or from my thyroid condition. I'm grateful to have the strength to do some work. I'm gaining weight due to my thyroid condition (Hypothyroidism), which isn't good for my heart. However, I'm trying to manage it and continue seeing my doctor for regular check-ups. I'm still on the same medication. I pray that my next cardiogram test will show that my heart is okay and I will no longer need medication.

I am grateful to God for providing our needs. Thank you for your prayers and continued support. May the Lord shower you with His blessings in return.
