Praise God for His goodness and mercy that he bestows upon us., I am grateful to the Lord for the strength he provides for me every day. Though not totally well my health is improving as I do some walking exercises every day. There are days that I feel better, and there are days not feeling well, still grateful for the strength, the medicine is helping me to recover gradually. I

went back to the doctor three days ago and he still wants me to continue taking all the medicines he prescribed to me a month ago. I'm taking seven kinds of medicine and two supplements, he adjusted some of the dosages of the medicines.

I'm not losing hope that I can still back to the prisons and be able to share Jesus with the men and women there. And be able to visit people and help them with their needs those who are sick elderly and widows. I'm praying for God's mercy that he will restore my health. Though I have fear, I just need to trust him constantly, especially in my situation I know He will never leave me nor forsake me and I hold on to that promise.

Thank you so much for being patient with me, and for supporting our needs here. It is a big help for us here, especially for me. I am also thankful for all your prayers for us.

I know many are suffering in some part of the world and devasted because of what happened to them and to their loved ones In calamities. I just prayed for them for strength and comfort as well.

Thank you for being there for us, as we face this trial. May God continue to bless you abundantly!
