- There must be at least two non-related attendants in the nursery at all times. If a couple is in nursery, there must be at least one other adult volunteering who is not related to them.
- One adult is required to be present for every four infants in the nursery. (This means that if there are five children, there must be two adult volunteers.) We can prepare for this by arranging for one adult to be on call OR by selecting an adult on the spot if the number of children requires such.
