I'm here again to give you an update on what is happening here with us and the ministry. I pray that you are healthy and had the Lord's protection.

Though we are still not allowed to visit people even in our nearest barangays grateful that we can able to go to church already for worship service, only 25% are allowed to attend. Because the infection of the virus is still increasing in our province.

We are also sad that the 92-year-old named Pipan, a faithful servant of the Lord who worked in the ministry when Brother Bob was still alive, died last August 28 and was buried already. His family was comforted that he was with the Lord already and free from the pain and troubles of this world.

I am doing my Bible lesson for the men in prison through videos; I send it to the prison and the officer in charge can play the video to them. I am glad that the prison management allowed me to continue my teaching through videos. I am still learning how to send it to them through the prison email address. I also continue to help the people who come to our house for their needs we are still giving them rice and we shared cooked foods too.

Angel and I are doing fine. We had flu but we are thankful to the Lord that we recovered already. We are thankful for answered prayer. Thank you for all your prayers for us. You are also included in our prayers and how thankful and blessed we are for your help.
