UPDATE: 11th Annual Beautiful Response Chili Supper on Tuesday, Nov. 8, from 4:30-7:00 PM at Bethel CRC. This year we are returning to an in-person event so you can once again enjoy amazing chili and fellowship. However, Beautiful Response has made the decision to change the beneficiary of the Chili Supper from RUHU to our partner organizations in Haiti--Help the Youth (HTY) and Mission: Love Haiti. Currently, there is a serious humanitarian and human rights crisis in Haiti which creates a much greater need for these organizations. The acute food insecurity, gang violence and related sexual violence, fuel crisis, and recent cholera outbreak have brought an already unstable and impoverished country to its breaking point. On a recent phone call with HTY's Executive Director Ticarme, she said, "I went behind my house and sat down in the chair and thought, we are all going to die." Essentially, the cost of food and fuel is so expensive due to the gang blockades and violence that people in Haiti are on the brink of starving. The plan is to use the funds from the Chili Supper to provide money for food and fuel so that they can access and purchase food. This year when you come out and support Beautiful Response, your support means the life-saving gift of food for the kids and families being served by HTY and Mission: Love Haiti.
