September 17th 2022 between 8am- 12pm—APPLICATIONS REQUIRED to be considered!

Who Can Apply?

- Persons who <u>live in and own</u> the <u>single family</u> residence where the work is to be done. Home is not for sale.
- 2. Are age 60 plus, if under age 60 receiving disability income.
- 3. Live in Fond du Lac County
- 4. Has not had furnace checked in the last 2 years.
- 5. Furnace is 10 years or older.
- 6. Did not participate in HEATS ON in 2021

How do I get an application?

Applications are available for pick-up at the ADRC or can be mailed to you by calling Melissa at 920-929-3521. Applications must be received on or before Monday, August 22, 2022.

How are homes selected?

How are homes Participants are chosen based on

- income,
- age of heating unit,
- condition of equipment
- and how many years since the last service.

Applications must be filled out COMPLETELY to be eligible.

This is a one-day event. There is no rescheduling or "rain checks".

Someone must be home on that day.

Who does the work?

Volunteers from the Local 400 Plumbers & Steamfitters inspect furnaces and replace filters. In addition they replace batteries in smoke detectors and make sure there is a working carbon monoxide detector. There are a limited number of homes that can be done.

Will I be notified if my home is selected?

Applicants who are selected will be notified on or before Friday, August 26, 2022.
