Honor God Serve Others Transform Lives



To our precious OGT family and friends,

After a month or so of planning, collecting, organizing and praying...the WI – Orphan Grain Train's air cargo load left the dock yesterday (April 15) around 12:15 p.m. Thank You Jesus!!! God has been so faithful, we have watched Him work miracle after miracle in these last five weeks. From huge donations of diapers and baby formula, to a 24-foot trailer load full of men's clothing, most of which were brand new, that arrived just in time! Men's work clothes and work boots are hard to come by, but it is one of the items the Ukraine has been desperately asking for. He has brought OGT family and friends together from all over the state and beyond, with car loads full of supplies. The monetary support towards these loads has also been overwhelming. There's been a lot of packing going on this last month, the boxes coming in are filled with lots of love and hope!! We pray our Ukrainian neighbors, thousands of miles away can feel the love being poured out for them!! I want to thank each one of you for your generosity and support, because without you, these loads of help would not be possible!! When we combine our gifts together they become mountains of HOPE!! Will you please be in prayer as our air flight heads out? That God would clear the way for this precious cargo to reach its destination quickly with no problems or delays!!! We are hoping within two weeks, maybe sooner if all goes perfect, Vitaliy will have these needed supplies!!

Wisconsin's air cargo load will head to New York and then fly to Vienna and from there it will be directly trucked into the Ukraine to our missionary Vitaliy Smolin, whose team will then begin distribution. One of the camps his team is helping is made up of 1700 refugees, who are coming and going continually. He has shared the sadness is overwhelming, prayers are needed to keep bitterness away. Death and devastation surround them...in his words..."we are exhausted, mentally and physically" But then, in the strength of the Spirit he continues to say, "I'm blessed and highly favored." Vitaliy knows God has placed him there, for such a time as this. God's light is never diminished, even in our darkest night, His love and presence always flicker through...unextinguishable!!

This next week, we will be loading a container for Latvia, which is a neighbor of Ukraine. Lord willing, we will be able to follow up these first two loads with another air cargo load and another container. Vitaliy shared that the next big need will soon become food. So that will be our next concentration along with other needed items. He also wanted you all to know how thankful and grateful they are to everyone, for their support, encouragement and prayers. They can feel the prayers uplifting them!!
