We praise God for his faithfulness and once again express our gratitude to all those that gave of their time, talents and treasures to the project, whether in the planning, construction, purchasing supplies, providing funds or surrounding the project with prayers.

 - The Building Fund will have about \$5,000 available for the general maintenance of the church building after the final parsonage and sound system bills. Please continue to support this fund as there are always ongoing facility needs.
 - Our remaining commitment to CWC for tuition is \$50,694.
